

# PRIMARY INSET WORKSHOPS

## Primary Drama - Taster Session

A practical short course which enables teachers to experience a range of simple drama approaches. Ideal as an introductory session for the dramatically terrified!

**Contents include:** drama games; exploring traditional story; mantle of the expert, improvisation; role-play; freeze-frames and hotseating.

## Drama Across The Curriculum

A session of pick-up-and-use drama games and activities including still images, teacher in role, hot-seating, ten-second objects, thought-tracking and visualisation. These strategies are designed to meet statutory drama and literacy objectives. The session includes an opportunity to apply the approaches to current curricular themes.

**Contents include:** using photos, artefacts and stories as starting points; activities to inspire speaking, listening, reading and writing; enhancing storytelling.

## Bullying

A practical 'fiction' orientated workshop looking at bullying from all points of view - the victim, the bully, the bully as victim etc. This can be tailored to work with a whole class or with a smaller group of children who are either bullies or victims of bullying.

**Contents include:** drama exercises; role-play; improvisation; freeze-frames and hot seating.
